



Guide for Erasmus+ KA171 Applicants (Undergraduate & Master Studies) University of Valladolid

1. Introduction

This guide is intended for Undergraduate & Master students interested in applying for a mobility exchange for STUDIES (Student Mobility for Studies – SMS) at the University of Valladolid (UVa) through the Erasmus+ KA171 programme for the 2026–27 academic year.

2. General Information about the Call

- Before applying, it is MANDATORY to read the official Call for Applications: https://uvamobplus2.uva.es/publico/download/192/en/CONVOCATORIA_SMS_2627_EN.pdf
- Type of mobility: Undergraduate & Master Student Mobility for Studies (SMS)
- Target group: Undergraduate & Master students at their home institution who are interested in carrying out subjects at the UVa
- Host institution: University of Valladolid (UVa)
- Traineeship period (depending on the selected offer):
 - 1st semester: 01/09/2026 – 31/01/2027
 - 2nd semester: 01/02/2027 – 30/07/2027
- Application process: individual, without nomination
- Applications submitted via UVAMOBPLUS2: <https://uvamobplus2.uva.es/publico/apply>
- Application deadline: 5 May 2026 (23:59 CET)
- Funding: Erasmus+ KA171 scholarship including:
 - Individual support for 5 months (850 EUR/month)
 - Travel support based on EU distance calculator (see Call)
 - Comprehensive medical and travel insurance
 - Tuition fee waiver at UVa
 - Additional financial support (250 EUR/month) for students with fewer opportunities (see Call)



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3. Available Academic Offer

Access to the catalogue of available programmes: <https://uvamobplus2.uva.es/publico/courses>

The available programmes can be found in the dropdown menu under the **Undergraduate** or **Master** options. Each programme includes information on the **language of instruction**, **mobility dates**, and a link located in the final column labelled “+ Info”, where applicants can find all details related to the study plan.

It is essential to **carefully read the full catalogue of offered programmes before submitting the application** to ensure that the selected programme meets the academic requirements of the home university and aligns with the opportunities provided by the University of Valladolid.

4. Submitting the Application

Steps to submit your application:

1. Access the platform: <https://uvamobplus2.uva.es/publico/apply>
2. Complete the online form.
3. Upload required documents (CV, mobility proposal, motivation letter, certificates, etc.)
4. Review all information
5. **Submit and mark the application as FINISHED before 5 May 2026 (23:59 CET)**
Important: if the application is edited during the call period, it must be submitted again and marked as FINAL in order to be considered.

5. Preparation of the Mobility Proposal

Step 5 of the online application includes a section for the **pre-selection of courses** that the student wishes to take within the chosen programme at the University of Valladolid. These courses must have **MANDATORY academic recognition** from the home institution.

Applications that do not provide proof of this academic recognition from the home university **will not be accepted**.

The form allows applicants to record the courses selected at the University of Valladolid and indicate the corresponding recognition at the home institution. Once completed, the system will generate a document that must be signed by both the **academic coordinator** and the **administrative coordinator** at the home university.

Applicants who do not submit both the **properly completed form** and the **duly signed document** will be excluded from the selection process.



6. Tips for a Strong Application

- **Review the study programme** using the website provided in the “Info” tab.
- **Write a personal and original motivation letter.** Letters generated by AI may be penalised.
- **Ensure that the application and all documentation are submitted in English or Spanish.** Documents in any other language will be discarded.
- **Demonstrate academic coherence** between the selected study programme and the curriculum at the home institution, ensuring an **equivalent workload**.

7. Academic Activities and Recognition

IMPORTANT:

- The mobility programme is intended for students who are pursuing **Undergraduate’s or Master’s studies** at their home university. The mobility to be carried out is **for STUDIES**, allowing students to take courses at the University of Valladolid.
- It is essential that the courses taken at the University of Valladolid have **MANDATORY ACADEMIC RECOGNITION** at the students’ home university. This requirement must be reflected in the mobility proposal and later in the final **Learning Agreement**, which will be signed by both the University of Valladolid and the students’ home university.

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9. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- **What are the language requirements?**

Each offer specifies the working language. Minimum required level: B2 (CEFR).

- **Can I choose any semester?**

No, it will depend on each programme offered. Each programme has its own schedule, either in the first semester or in the second.

- **How long is the mobility period?**

All mobility exchanges last 5 months.

- **Can I apply to more than one offer?**

No. Only one academic programme may be applied for; therefore, it is advisable to review the catalogue of offers carefully before submitting the application.

- **Can the mobility proposal be modified later?**

Yes. If you are selected, the final definition of the mobility proposal will be completed **before the start of the mobility**, together with the academic coordinator of the programme, who will serve as your academic tutor both at the University of Valladolid and at your home university.

The final plan will be reflected in the official **Learning Agreement**, which is provided only to selected applicants.
